



## **Policy for Endorsing Candidates**

**Preserve Navarre** seeks to honor and empower candidates for local, state, and federal office who will represent Navarre and serve the community. To this end the policy below specifies and regulates the group's support for candidates for political office.

### **Requirements**

- Candidates for political office must adhere to all applicable local, state, and federal guidelines and requirements regarding the office that they seek.
- Candidates for political office must present a platform that is clear, compelling, and consistent with Preserve Navarre's core values.

#### **Preserve Navarre Core Values**

- Resident Focused
- Transparency
- Responsible Growth
- Constitutional Government
- Quality of Life

- Candidates seeking Preserve Navarre's endorsement must submit to an independent background check financed by the Preserve Navarre group.
- Preserve Navarre is nonpartisan. Any endorsement of a candidate must be based on an individual's integrity and merit as a candidate and not as an endorsement of a political party or partisan ideology.
- Endorsement of a candidate requires unanimous consent by the board and a majority vote by the members of Preserve Navarre.
- Endorsement and any support for political office by Preserve Navarre must be specified in writing for awareness by all group members.
- No member dues shall be utilized for campaign support or donations to candidates of any kind, regardless of endorsement.
